 Kindergarten - 4th Grade

Nursery School (2 yrs), Preschool (3 yrs), and PreKindergarten (4 yrs) options: (For the best prep for our Kindergarten we recommend 5 full or 5 half days in PreK. Full days = 8:30-3:15, Half days = 8:30-11:20 am, or 12:20-3:15 pm. *Add 1 hr Lunch time/recess to a half day for \$6.00/day.

<u>Tuition Payment Options</u> (auto paid online through FACTS)

- ❖ PAY IN FULL in one payment by Aug 1st each school year and save!
 - > No tuition deposit required. (For a granted early withdrawal, one month's tuition is retained.)
 - > No tuition insurance required.
 - > \$25.00 one time FACTS processing fee
- ♦ MONTHLY PAYMENTS: Pay total over 9-12 months (in full by May 31 each year)
 - One month Tuition deposit required upon initial contract signing, applied to the last month of tuition when discontinuing for the next school year. Non-refundable in the case of a Board granted early withdrawal/contract release. (<u>Tuition Deposit FAQs</u>)
 - > \$350 Tuition Insurance, paid upon signing.
 - > \$55.00 one time FACTS processing fee

Fees: (Non-refundable)

Annual Enrollment Fee: due at contract signing and Feb 1 each year

\$175.00/yr/student

To reserve a continuous space for your student, this non-refundable enrollment fee is due upon initial contract signing, and upon contract renewal on Feb 1^{st} of each year.

Field trips/Textbooks/Supplies Fee: due by first school day

\$425/yr/std (\$325 NS-PS)

Covers textbooks, planners, and school day field trips planned at the beginning of the year. Extra trips may be added at a small extra cost. Does not cover yearbooks, lost textbooks, special mini-courses, lead role play costumes, special school events, or overnight/out of town trips.

Application/Testing fee: one time fee

^{**}Tuition prices are for a **full year** of school. An early withdrawal/contract release must be Board approved, as the payment of a full year's tuition is typically unconditional and irrevocable.)

Sibling Discounts:

For families paying more than one full tuition we offer sibling discounts. (These discounts are not applied in addition to other discounts or scholarships. They are meant to help families who are paying more than one full tuition out of pocket.)
